Grace - Ribbons will be updated with the Cassia Fair logo. Cordel made motion to order the plastic trophies. Tony seconded, motion passed. Banners have been ordered. Change the color of the participant ribbons to lime green. 250 rabbits will be weighed in and tattooed on Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> 5-7 PM. Carla and Cordell will be there.

Some of the goats will be re-tagged. The 4-H office is setting up a day.

Pre fair BBQ July 24 6 P. FCS will meet at 5 pm with species to follow after dinner. Families invited.

Want to do a petting zoo on Thursday evening of the fair for families to come see and touch animals in the Jack Funk Pavilion 5-7 PM. Grace asked if we could make the 4H building bathrooms to generics. Carla will order signs.

Lions wants to make an agreement on the fees for the next several years as far as paying booth space. It was said that they shouldn't have to pay for at least the next 10 years. We will all work together. Fair board will order concrete. Plans are underway to start the building.

Jeff sent a proposal from Coors. The board declined the proposal. Jeff can get back with them.

Contractors will be back after the tractor pulls to complete the bleachers. Leave fence across back of grandstands. Tab has concerns for garbage cans around grandstands.

Discussion with Burley Iron works to build the crows nest.

Need to schedule work days. Finish the beet room.

Commissioner Beck mentioned he was working on getting the fair board a new printer.

Wesley is collecting logos. Needs to know who the national anthem singers are. Is Cal Ranch participating again this year. Tony will check with Cal Ranch. Don't have a sponsor for Mutton Busting. It was suggested that Wesley call Young Ford to be the sponsor.

Parking sponsors were discussed. Suggestion was made to get two parking sponsors. \$3000 - \$5000 each. Ask First Federal about being a parking sponsor.

Carla gave the schedule for the ticket booth. Nicole asked if we could up the salary for the people helping in the ticket booth. Todd made motion to increase their pay. Tony second. It was approved.

Carla read minutes. Cordell moved to accept minutes as read. Todd Seconded motion accepted  
Chimene met with Cordell. The Rotary Club wants to help in any way they can.
